#### Gentlemen:

By this letter of application Amerada Petroleum Corporation wishes to state the following facts:

- That Amerada is the operator of the L. W. Ward No. 2, located 1983' FSL and 520' FEL of Section 11, T-13-S, R-38-E, Lea County, New Mexico, in the Bronco Field.
- 2. That the subject well is presently completed in the Bronco (Devonian) Pool.
- 3. That applicant proposes to dually complete the subject well in an undesignated Mississippian Pool and in the Bronco (Devonian) Pool.
- 4. That this will be the second Mississippian completion in the Bronco Field. The first was the Amerada - L. R. Weems No. 7, which is located across the New Mexico-Texas state line from the subject well. A plat of the area is attached.
- 5. That the proposed dual completion will be effected by setting a permanent type packer between the two producing zones and running two parallel strings of 2-1/16" OD CS Hydril tubing.
- That details of the proposed dual completion are shown on the "Application for Dual Completion" form and the diagrammatic sketch attached to this letter.
