

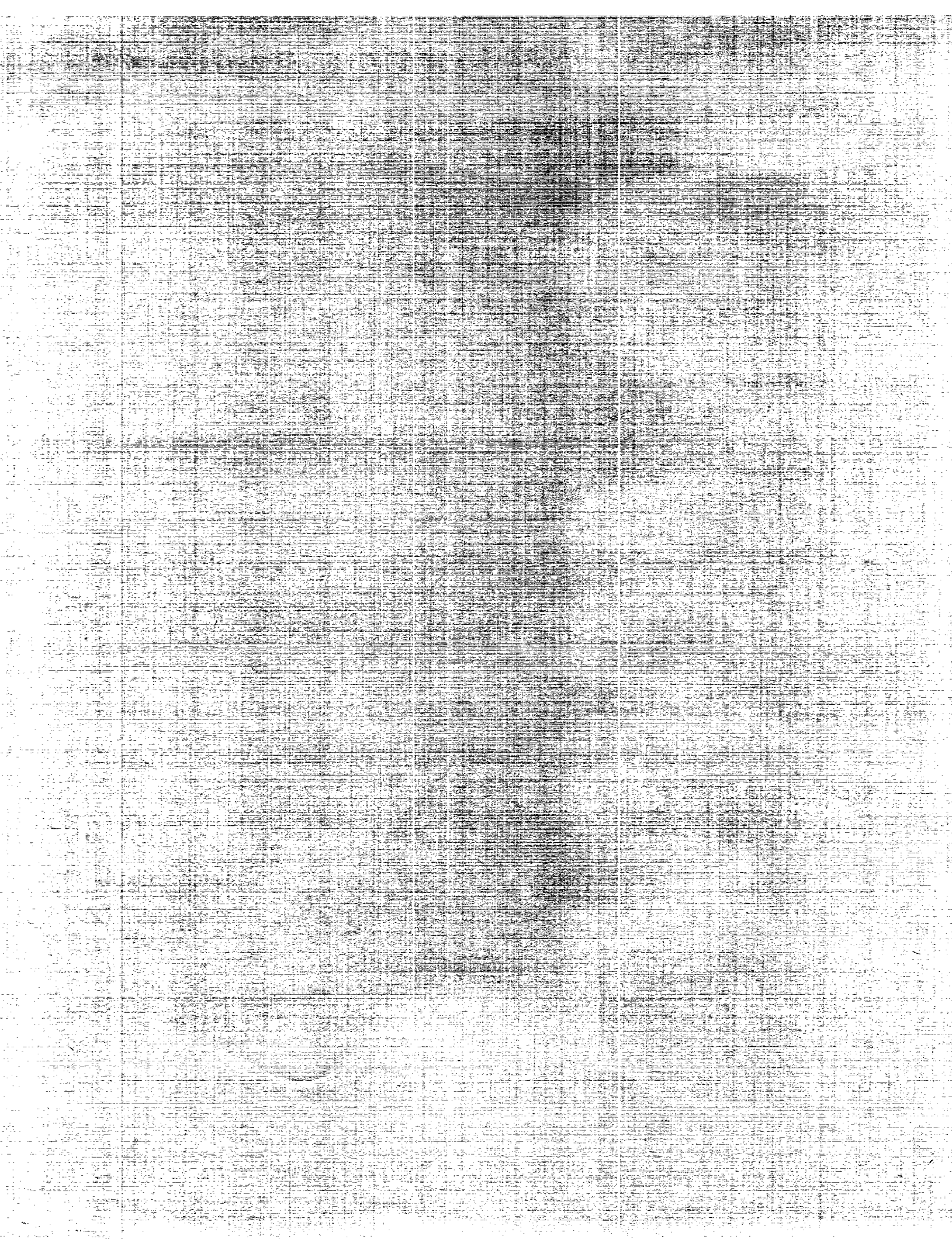

Gentlemen:

This will have reference to Mr. E. J. Fischer's letter to Mr. J. W. Brown dated March 31, 1959, and previous correspondence between our Hobbs, New Mexico Office and the New Mexico Oil Conservation Commission.

Pan American Petroleum Corporation respectfully requests an Examiner Hearing for the purpose of obtaining an order approving the dual completion of its W. H. Turner No. 1, located in the SE/4 SE/4 Section 29, T-21-S, R-37-E, Lea County, New Mexico. This well is dually completed for oil from the Drinkard Pool and for gas from the vertical limits of the Eumont Pool but is located outside the now defined horizontal limits of the Eumont Pool. A Guiberson KVL 30 hook-wall packer was used to effect the separation between zones.

Since this well is now dually completed and a market has been obtained for the Eumont gas, we desire to obtain an Examiner Hearing at the earliest possible date so that the well may be placed on production from both zones.

Attached is a sketch illustrating the equipment used in the dual completion and a plat showing the well location.
