Applicant is owner and operator of the State $^{"}A"$ No. 1 Well, located in the SE_{4}^{1} of Section 16, Township 20 South, Range 37 East, Lea County, New Mexico, originally completed in the Eunice-Monument-Grayburg Zone as defined in Order No. R-520, and perforated at an interval between 3750 to 3770 feet;
- 2. Said well by additional drilling has encountered a lower zone productive of oil and other hydrocarbons perforated at an interval of 6455 to 6508 feet, undesignated but here known as the Eunice-Monument-Tubb Zone, separate from the upper zone here identified:
- Applicant requests approval to dually complete said well in order to separately produce from the two formations here identified and to commingle the oil produced from the two zones; production to be through perellit Turned to to go

WHEREFORE, Applicant requests that this matter be set for hearing, that notice thereof be given as required by law, and upon hearing that this Commission enter its order authorizing dual completion of the State "Q" No. 1 Well and the commingling of oil produced from the two zones here identified.
