THE APPLICATION OF THE OIL CONSERVATION COMMISSION UPON ITS OWN LOTION FOR AN ORDER CREATING AND EXTENDING CERTAIN POOLS IN CHAVES, EDDY, AND LEA COUNTIES, NEW MEXICO

ORDER OF THE COMMISSION

BY THE COMMISSION:

This cause came on for hearing at 9 o'clock a.m. on September 16, 1959, at Santa Fe, New Mexico, before the Oil Conservation Commission of New Mexico, herinafter referred to as the "Commission."

NOW, on this 22nd day of September, 1959, the Commission, a quorum being present, having considered the testimony presented and the exhibits received at said hearing, and being fully advised in the premises,

FINDS:

- (1) That due public notice having been given as required by law, the Commission has jurisdiction of this cause and the subject matter thereof.
- (2) That there is need for the creation of a new pool in Lea County, New Mexico, for the production of oil from the Pennsylvanian formation, said pool to bear the designation Baish-Pennsylvanian Pool. Said Baish-Pennsylvanian Pool was discovered by Continental Oil Company, M. E. Baish "A" Well No. 27, located in the SE/4 of Section 21, Township 17 South, Range 32 East, NaPM. It was completed June 15, 1959. The top of perforations is at 10,726 feet.
- (3) That there is need for the creation of a new pool in Eddy County, New Mexico, for the production of oil from the Brushy Canyon formation, said pool to beer the designation Cetton Draw-Brushy Canyon Pool. Said Cotton Draw-Brushy Canyon Pool was discovered by Texaco, Inc., Heflin Federal Well No. 1, located in the SE/4 of Section 24, Township 24 South, Range 31 East, NMPM. It was completed in Brushy Canyon formation June 22, 1959. The top of perforations is at 7184 feet.

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- (4) That there is need for the creation of a new pool in Chaves County, New Mexico, for the production of oil from the Devonian formation, said pool to bear the designation King Camp-Devonian Pool. Said King Camp-Devonian Pool was discovered by the British American Oil Producing Company, Honolulu Federal Well No. 1, located in the NE/4 of Section 27, Township 14 South, Range 29 East, NMPM. It was completed July 21, 1959. The top of perforations is at 10,222 feet.
- (5) That there is need for the creation of a new pool in Lea County, New Mexico, for the production of gas from the Tubb formation, said pool to bear the designation Weir-Tubb Gas Pool. Said Weir-Tubb Gas Pool was discovered by Continental Oil Company, Britt B-15 Well No. 9, located in the SE/4 of Section 15, Township 20 South, Range 37 East, NaPhr. It was completed april 24, 1959. The top of perforations is at 6474 feet.
- (6) That there is need for certain extensions to the Little Lucky-Lake Devonian Pool in Chaves County, New Mexico; and to Robinson Pool in Eddy County, New Mexico; and to the Bishop Canyon Pool, the Four Lakes-Devonian Gas Pool, the Jalmat Gas Pool, the Justis Drinkard Pool, the Maljamar Pool, the Roberts Pool, the Skaggs Pool, the Teas Pool, and the Wilson Pool, all in Lea County, New Mexico.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

(a) That a new pool in Lea County, New Mexico, classified as an oil pool for Pennsylvanian production, be and the same is hereby created and designated as the Baish-Pennsylvanian Pool, consisting of the following described area:

TOWNSHIP 17 SOUTH, RANGE 32 EAST, NEIPHE Section 21: SE/4

(b) That a new pool in Eddy County, New Mexico, classified as an oil pool for Brushy Canyon production, be and the same is hereby created and designated as the Cotton Draw-Brushy Canyon pool, consisting of the following described area:

TOWNSHIP 24 SOUTH, RANGE 31 EAST, NaPa.

Section 24: SE/4

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(i) That the Little Lucky Lake-Devonian Pool in Chaves County, New Mexico, as heretofore classified, defined, and described, be and the same is hereby extended to include therein:

TOWNSHIP 15 SOUTH, RANGE 30 EAST, NAPAS Section 29: SE/4

(j) That the Maljamar Pool in Lea County, New Mexico, as hertofore classified, defined, and described, be and the same is hereby extended to include therein:

TOWNSHIP 17 SOUTH, RANGE 32 EAST, NA.PM Section 13: NE/4 & SW/4

TOWNSHIP 17 SOUTH, RANGE 33 EAST, Na.PM. Section 16: NW/4

(k) That the Roberts Pool in Lea County, Ne Mexico, as heretofore classified, defined, and described, be and the same is bereby extended to include therein:

TOWNSHIP 17 SOUTH, RANGE 32 EAST, NE.PM. Section 12: SE/4

(1) That the Robinson Pool in Eddy County, New Mexico, as heretofore classified, defined, and described, be and the same is hereby extended to include therein:

TOWNSHIP 17 SOUTH, RANGE 31 EAST, NMPM Section 11: NE/4 NW/4

(m) That the Skaggs Pool in Lea County, New Mexico, as heretofore classified, defined, and described, be and the same is hereby extended to include therein:

TOWNSHIP 20 SOUTH, RANGE 38 EAST, Na.PM Section 20: NW/4

(n) That the Teas Pool in Lea County, New Mexico, as heretofore classified, defined, and described, be and the same is hereby extended to include therein:

TOWNSHIP 20 SOUTH, RANGE 33 EAST, NA.PM Section 23: W/2

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(o) That the Wilson Pool in Lea County, New Mexico, as hertofore classified, defined, and described, be and the same is hereby extended to include therein:

TOWNSHIP 21 SOUTH, RANGE 35 EAST, NMPA. Section 29: NW/4

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED:

That the effective date of this order and all creations and extensions included herein shall be October 1, 1959.
