MR. PORTER: Take up next Case 1789.

MR. PAYNE: Case 1789. Northwestern New Mexico nomenclature case calling for an order for the extension of existing pools in San Juan, Sandoval and Rio Arriba Counties, New Mexico.

(Witness sworn)

A. R. KENDRICK,
 called as a witness, having been first duly sworn, testified as follows:

DIRECT EXAMINATION

BY MR. PAYNE:

Q Will the witness please state his name and position?

A A. R. Kendrick, engineer for the Oil Conservation Commission.

Q Mr. Kendrick, in your capacity with the Oil Conservation Commission, have you made a study concerning the necessity or desirability for extending certain pools in San Juan, Sandoval and Rio Arriba Counties, New Mexico?

A I have.

Q What are your recommendations concerning the extension of the Blanco-Pictured Cliffs Pool?

A I recommend that the Blanco-Pictured Cliffs Pool be extended as shown on Exhibit 1, Paragraph (a) on the basis of one well capable of producing from that Pool.

Q What are your recommendations concerning the extension of the Tapacito-Pictured Cliffs Pool?

A I recommend that the Tapacito-Pictured Cliffs Pool be extended as shown on Exhibit 1, Paragraph (b) on the basis of one well producing from that Pool.

Q What are your recommendations concerning extension of the Horseshoe-Gallup Pool?

A I recommend the Horseshoe-Gallup Oil Pool be extended as shown on Exhibit 1, Paragraph (c) based on nine wells producing from that pool.

Q What are your recommendations concerning extension of the Verde-Gallup Oil Pool?

A I recommend the Verde-Gallup Oil Pool be extended

as shown on Paragraph (d) of Exhibit 1, on the basis of one well capable of producing from that Pool.

Q What are your recommendations concerning the extension of the Angels Peak-Dakota Pool?

A I recommend the Angels Peak-Dakota Pool be extended as shown in Paragraph (e) of Exhibit 1, on the basis of five wells producing from that Pool.

Q What are your recommendations concerning extension of the West Kutz-Dakota Pool?

A I recommend that Pool be extended as shown on Paragraph (f) of Exhibit 1, on the basis of one well producing from that Pool.

Q What are your recommendations concerning extension of the Ballard-Pictured Cliffs Pool?

A I recommend the Ballard-Pictured Cliffs Pool be extended as shown on Paragraph (g) of Exhibit 1, being Township 24 North, Range 6 West; Section 8, the SE/4 Section 17, the NE/4 on the basis of one well producing from that Pool.

Q Have you prepared Exhibits substantiating your recommendations?

A I have.

Q How is this designated?

A In Oil Conservation Commission's Exhibit No. 1, Case 1789.

MR. PAYNE: Mr. Examiner, I move for the introduc-

tion of Exhibit 1 in Case 1789.

MR. PORTER: Without objection, the Exhibit will be admitted.
