A P P L I C A T I O N

Applicant states:

1. That it is the owner and operator of an oil and gas
lease known as its E. O. Carson lease, which includes the
following lands:

West half of the Southwest quarter (W/2 SW/4)
and Southeast quarter of the Southwest quarter
(SE/4 SW/4) of Section 28; and Northwest
quarter (NW/4) and Southwest quarter of the
Northeast quarter (SW/4 NE/4) of Section 33;
all in Township 21 South, Range 37 East,
Lea County, New Mexico.

2. That wells located upon said lease are producing
from the Brunson Pool, Drinkard Pool, Hare Pool, Wantz Abo Pool,
Blinebry (Gas) Pool and Tubb (Gas) Pool.

3. That applicant, in order to obtain a saving of
produced hydrocarbons, proposes to commingle the production from
said pools by consolidating tankage; and that the production from
each reservoir will be metered.

4. That attached hereto and made a part hereof is a
plat marked Exhibit A showing the wells located on applicant's
E. O. Carson lease and surrounding leases.
