called as a witness, having been first duly sworn, testified as follows:

DIRECT EXAMINATION

BY MR. PAYNE:

Q Will the witness please state his name and position?

A A. R. Kendrick, District Engineer for the Oil Conservation Commission.

Q Mr. Kendrick, in your official capacity with the Oil Conservation Commission, have you made a study concerning the necessity or desirability for extending certain existing pools in San Juan, Rio Arriba and Sandoval Counties, New Mexico?

A I have.

Q What are your recommendations concerning extension of the Aztec-Fruitland Pool?

A That it be extended as shown in Paragraph (a) of Exhibit 1 on the basis of one well producing from that pool.

Q What are your recommendations concerning extension of the Aztec-Pictured Cliffs Pool?

A That it be extended as shown in Paragraph (b) of Exhibit 1 on the basis of one well capable of producing from that pool.

Q What are your recommendations concerning extension of the Ballard-Pictured Cliffs Pool?

A That that pool be extended as shown in Paragraph (c)

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of Exhibit 1 on the basis of two wells producing from that pool.

Q What are your recommendations concerning extension of the Fulcher Kutz-Pictured Cliffs Pool?

A That the pool be extended as shown in Paragraph (d) of Exhibit 1 on the basis of one well producing from that pool.

Q What are your recommendations concerning extension of the Gavilan-Pictured Cliffs Pool?

A That the pool be extended as shown in Paragraph (e) of Exhibit 1 on the basis of one well completed in that pool.

Q What are your recommendations concerning extension of the South Blanco-Pictured Cliffs Pool?

A That the pool be extended as shown in Paragraph (f) of Exhibit 1 on the basis of two wells completed in the pool.

Q What are your recommendations concerning extension of the Otero-Chacra Pool?

A That the pool be extended as shown in Paragraph (g) of Exhibit 1 on the basis of one well completed in that pool.

Q What are your recommendations concerning extension of the Angels Peak-Gallup Oil Pool?

A That the pool be extended as shown in Paragraph (h) of Exhibit 1 on the basis of one well capable of producing from that pool.

Q What are your recommendations concerning extension of Horseshoe-Gallup Oil Pool?

A That the pool be extended as shown in Paragraph (i)



of Exhibit 1 on the basis of three wells completed in that pool.

Q What are your recommendations concerning extension of the Verde-Gallup Oil Pool?

A That the pool be extended as shown in Paragraph (j) of Exhibit 1 on the basis of one well capable of producing from that pool.

Q What are your recommendations concerning extension of the Angels Peak-Dakota Pool?

A That the pool be extended as shown in Paragraph (k) of Exhibit 1, on the basis of nine wells completed in that pool.

Q What are your recommendations concerning extension of the South Blanco-Dakota Pool?

A That the pool be extended as shown in Paragraph (l) of Exhibit 1 on the basis of one well completed in that pool.

Q What are your recommendations concerning extension of the West Kutz-Dakota Pool?

A That the pool be extended as shown in Paragraph (m) of the Exhibit 1 on the basis of seven wells completed in that pool.

Q Mr. Kendrick, have you prepared an exhibit substantiating your recommendations?

A I have.
