We are this day making application to the New Mexico Gil Conservation Commission for permission to instigate a water flood project located in Sections 35 and 36, Township 12 South, Range 31 East, and Sections 1, 2, 3, and 11, Township 13 South, Range 31 East, all in Chaves County, New Mexico. We are enclosing with this letter a copy of our application to the Commission.

We propose to obtain water for this project from the Northeast quarter of Section 2, Township 13 South, Range 31 East, Chaves County, New Mexico. The formation from which the water will be obtained will be the Ogallale, the top of which should be found at about 160 feet deep. The base of the Ogallala Formation will be at approximately 205 feet.

This water well has not been drilled; therefore, an analysis of the water is not svailable at this time. However, as soon as the well is drilled, an analysis of the water will be furnished to you. We anticipate the analysis of the water will be quite similar to other Ogallala water. We have previously submitted to you analyses in the same area.
