- B. That by requiring that this report be postmarked not later than the 15th of the second succeeding month would result in a labor savings to all operators that are in a joint salt water disposal system.

To: All Operators of Water Disposal Systems

Subject: Revision of OCC Form C-120 Concerning Reporting on Salt Water Disposal Operations

A special committee of Amerada, Continental and Gulf (Chairman) appointed by the Committee Members of the E-M-E Salt Water Disposal System, has been working with the New Mexico Oil Conservation Commission on the captioned subject.

A meeting of all operators of disposal systems (list attached) and certain Commission Staff members is called for 10:30 a.m., MST, February 11, 1960 at the Hobbs Oil Conservation Commission office. The purpose of this meeting is to discuss the present method of reporting the resultant problems and formulate a method of reporting of data.

It is the opinion of the above special committee that from a meeting of all operators of water disposal systems the problem of each operator can be discussed and that a more desirable and workable method of reporting water disposal data can be accomplished. For your consideration, a proposed form (worked on by the OCC and members of the above special committee) is attached.

Following this meeting, it is planned to ask the Commission to call a hearing for revision of Form C-120 concerning reporting requirements for SWD operations.
