A P P L I C A T I O N

Comes now Caulkins Oil Company and applies to the Oil Conservation Commission of New Mexico for an order approving the dual completion of its Sanchez Well No. 1 for production of gas from the Dakota formation and gas from the Pictured Cliffs formation, and in support thereof would show:

1. That the Caulkins Oil Company Sanchez Well No. 1 is located 560 feet from the North line and 660 feet from the West line of Section 24, Township 26 North, Range 6 West, and is within the horizontal boundaries of the South Blanco-Pictured Cliffs gas pool.

2. That applicant proposes to complete said well for production of gas from the Dakota Formation and gas from the Pictured Cliffs formation, in conformity with practices heretofore approved by the Oil Conservation Commission. Said well is presently completed in and producing from the Pictured Cliffs formation.

3. That the approval of said dual completion is in the interests of conservation, the greater ultimate recovery of gas, and will prevent waste and protect correlative rights.
