ORDER OF THE COMMISSION

BY THE COMMISSION:

This cause came on for hearing at 9 o'clock a.m. on April 27, 1960, at Santa Fe, New Mexico, before Elvis A. Uts, Examiner duly appointed by the Gil Conservation Commission of New Mexico, hereinafter referred to as the "Commission," in accordance with Rule 1214 of the Commission Rules and Regulations.

NOW, on this 9th day of May, 1960, the Commission, a quorum being present, having considered the application, the evidence adduced, and the resommendations of the Examiner, Elvis A. Utz, and being fully advised in the premises,

FINDS:

- (1) That due public motice having been given as required by law, the Commission has jurisdiction of this cause and the subject matter thereof.
- (2) That the applicant, Texaco Inc., is the owner and operator of the NE/4 of Section 5 and the N/2 of Section 4, Township 24 South, Range 37 Rast, NMFM, Lea County, New Mexico.
- (3) That the applicant proposes that the above-described 476-acre truck be established as a non-standard gas provision unit in the Jalmat Gas Pool to be dedicated to its B. D. Fanning Well No. 6, located 660 feet from the North line and 660 feet from the West line of said Section 4.
- (4) That the above-described 476-acre tract can reasonably be presumed to be productive of gas from the Jalmat Gas Pool.
- (5) That establishment of the above-described non-standard gas proration unit will neither cause waste nor impair correlative rights.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

- (1) That a 476-acre non-standard gas proration unit in the Jalmat Gas Pool consisting of the HR/4 of Section 5 and the M/2 of Section 4. Township 24 South, Range 37 Hast, MMPM, Lea County, New Maxico, be and the same is hereby established. Said unit is to be dedicated to the H. D. Famming Well No. 6, located 660 feet from the North line and 660 feet from the West line of said Section 4.
- (2) That the said E. D. Fanning Well No. 6 be and the same is hereby assigned an acreage factor for allowable purposes in the proportion that the acreage in the non-standard gas provation unit bears to the acreage in a standard gas provation unit in the Jalmat Gas Pool, subject to the provisions of the special Rules and Regulations for said Pool.
 - (3) That the effective date of this order is June 1, 1960.
