Gentlemen:

Case 1952, the application of TEXACO Inc. for a 476-acre nonstandard proration unit to be dedicated to its E. D. Fanning Well No. 6 in the Jalmat Gas Pool, Lea County, New Mexico, was heard on April 27, 1960. Presiding at this hearing was Examiner E. A. Utz.

After making a diligent effort, TEXACO Inc. has been unable to complete its E. D. Fanning No. 6 in the Jalmat Gas Pool. While the geological and engineering data indicated a commercial well, we have been unable to complete the well as a commercial producer, and the well will be abandoned in this zone. If a formal order has not been issued, TEXACO Inc. respectfully requests that its application for an NSP unit be dismissed.
