APPLICATION

Comes now SHELL OIL COMPANY and requests an exception to
Rules 303 and Section (a) of Rule 309 of the Rules of the New
Mexico Oil Conservation Commission:

1. The applicant requests authority to commingle oil produc-
ed from the Queen Zone with production from the San Andreas Forma-
tion and Atoka Formation, and to commingle same with production
from the Pearl Queen Field on two Shell leases described as follows:

Shell's Linam Lease consisting of 80 acres in
the NE 1/4 of the NE 1/4 and NW 1/4 of the
NW 1/4, Section 3, T-20-S, R-35E,

Shell's Lowe Land Lease consisting of 80 acres
in the NW 1/4 of the NE 1/4 and NE 1/4 of the
NW 1/4, Section 3, T-20-S, R-35-E.

2. The production from each Lease will be separately metered
prior to commingling.

3. Applicant further requests authority to install an auto-
matic custody transfer unit to automatically transfer crude oil to
the pipe line.
