
BEFORE THE OIL CONSERVATION COMMISSION

IN THE MATTER OF THE APPLICATION OF ARGO OIL CORPORATION FOR AN ORDER COMPULSORILY POOLING ALL INTERESTS IN THE ENEX OF SECTION 21 and THE WNX of SECTION 22, TOWNSHIP 25 SOUTH, RANGE 37 EAST, LEA COUNTY, NEW MEXICO, BEING IN THE JALMAT GAS POOL.



APPLICATION

COMES NOW Applicant, Argo Oil Corporation, by its attorneys and states:

- 1. Applicant is the owner of leasehold rights covering the E½NE½ of Section 21 and the NW½NW½ and the SW½NW½ of Section 22, Township 25 South, Range 37 East, N.M.P.M., Lea County, New Mexico, and is the owner of an undivided 1/2 interest in the oil, gas and other minerals underlying the E½NE½ of Section 21 and the W½NW½ of Section 22, Township 25 South, Range 37 East, N.M.P.M., Lea County, New Mexico.
- 2. By its Order No. 1794, the New Mexico Oil Conservation Commission established a gas proration unit within the limits of the Jalmat Gas Pool consisting of the E2NE2 of Section 21 and the W2NW2 of Section 22, Township 25 South, Range 37 East, N.M.P.M., Lea County, New Mexico.
- 3. Applicant has attempted to obtain a voluntary gas pooling agreement from the owners of interest other than those owned by Applicant within the limits of the Jalmat Gas Pool under the gas proration unit and due to matters beyond the control of Applicant such voluntary pooling agreement cannot now be obtained.

WHEREFORE, Applicant requests the Commission to set this matter down before an examiner for the Commission, to publish notice as required by law, and, after hearing, to issue its order pooling all interests under the described gas proration unit within the limits of the Jalmat Gas Pool.
