Dear Mr. Mutter:

Yesterday in Artesia, I handed to Mr. Armstrong of that office a plat showing the proposed change in the unorthodox location granted under subject case. The proposed new location is 2060 feet from the East Line and 1810 feet from the North Line. You will see from the plat that the location granted in the original order lies in a dedicated street which is within 25 feet of the Santa Fe Railroad right of way.

After a meeting with the operating partners in Artesia yesterday, the Yates Petroleum Corporation, owners of leases on lots on which the proposed location would be made joined with me in this request. They feel the location should not be in a dedicated street. Also, the block on which the new location would be made has title clearance from their attorneys.

I respectfully request that you grant this location change administratively in order that we may commence the drilling of this well at an early date.
