This letter is to request that you withdraw our application for dual completion of the Neville G. Penrose, Inc. Grizzell #1 as it was originally submitted. This application requested permission to produce gas from the Tubbs Pool and oil from the Drinkard Pool through the casing annulus and 2 3/8" tubing respectively. Hearing on this application was scheduled for August 24, 1960 at the regular examiners hearing and was assigned Case #2040.
