Comes now applicant, Continental Oil Company, and respectfully requests an exception to statewide (Rule No. 309(a)) for permission to install an automatic custody transfer system for five wells producing from the (Cass Pool) and one well producing from the Weir Pool within the boundaries of the Southeast Monument Unit located in Section 23, T-20S, R-37E, NMPM, Lee County, New Mexico, and in support thereof would show:

 That the applicant is co-owner and operator of the Southeast Monument Unit, a portion of which consists of Section 23, T-205, R-37E, NMPM, Lea County, New Mexico.

2. That the royalty interests are common, that being the United States Government.

3. That applicant proposes to consolidate the existing tank batteries and install an automatic custody transfer system.

5. That the proposed installation in exception to Rule 309(a) is in the interest of conservation and prevention of waste.

Wherefore, applicant prays that this matter be set for hearing before the Commission's duly qualified examiner and that upon hearing an order be entered granting applicant permission to install an automatic custody transfer system on the above described property.
