ORDER OF THE COMMISSION

BY THE COMMUSSION:

This cause came on for hearing at 9 o'clock a.m. on September 21, 1960, at Santa Pe, New Mexico, hefore Daniel 5. Mutter, Examiner duly appointed by the Gil Conservation Commission of New Mexico, hereinafter referred to as the "Commission," in accordance with Rule 1214 of the Commission Rules and Regulations.

MOW, on this 3rd day of October, 1960, the Commission, a quorum being present, having considered the application, the evidence adduced, and the recommendations of the Examiner, Daniel S. Mutter, and being fully advised in the premises,

FINDS:

- (1) That due public notice having been given as required by law, the Commission has jurisdiction of this cause and the subject matter thereof.
- (2) That the applicant proposes to store Empire-Abo Pool oil production from its Malco "H" Lease, comprising the MW/4 and the M/2 SW/4 of Section 15, Township 18 South, Range 27 East, MMPM, Eddy County, New Mexico, in a separate tank battery to be located on its State "BR" Lease, comprising the HE/4 ME/4 of Section 16, Township 18 South, Range 27 East, MMPM, Eddy County, New Mexico.
- (3) That the said Empire-Abo Pool oil production from the above-described Malco "H" Lease will not be commingled with the production from any other lease, including the production from the said State "BR" Lease.
- (4) That approval of the subject application will neither cause waste nor impair correlative rights.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

That the applicant, Fan American Petroleum Corporation, be and the same is hereby authorised to store Empire-Abo Pool oil production from its Malco "H" Lease, comprising the HW/4 and the M/2 SW/4 of Section 15, Township 18 South, Range 27 Rest, HMPM, Eddy County, New Maxico, in a separate tank bettery to be located on its State "BR" Lease, comprising the HE/4 HE/4 of Section 16, Township 18 South, Range 27 Rest, MMPM, Eddy County, New Mexico.

PROVIDED HOWEVER, That the said Empire-Abo Pool oil production from the said Malco "H" Lease shall not be commingled with the production from any other lease, including the production from the said State "BR" Lease.
