ORDER OF THE COMMISSION

BY THE COMMISSION:

This cause came on for hearing at 9 o'clock a.m. on October 13, 1960, at Farmington, New Mexico, before the Oil Conservation Commission of New Mexico, hereinafter referred to as the "Commission".

NOW, on this 14th day of October, 1960, the Commission, a quorum being present, having considered the testimony presented and the exhibits received at said hearing, and being fully advised in the premises,

FINDS:

(1) That due public notice having been given as required by law, the Commission has jurisdiction of this cause and the subject matter thereof.

(2) That there is need for certain extensions to the Tapacito-Pictured Cliffs Pool and to the Otero-Gallup Pool in Rio Arriba County, New Mexico, and to the Aztec-Pictured Cliffs Pool, to the Blanco-Pictured Cliffs Pool, to the West Kutz-Pictured Cliffs Pool and to the Verde-Gallup Oil Pool, all in San Juan County, New Mexico, to the South Blanco-Pictured Cliffs Pool and to the Blanco-Mesaverde Pool in Rio Arriba and San Juan Counties, New Mexico.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

(a) That the Aztec-Pictured Cliffs Pool in San Juan County, New Mexico, as heretofore classified, defined, and described, be
