OBJECTION OF POTASH COMPANY OF AMERICA


Potash Company of America, a Colorado Corporation, authorized to do business in the State of New Mexico hereby objects to the drilling of an exploratory test well in the SW 1/4 SE 1/4 of Section 18, T. 20S., R. 34E., Lea County, New Mexico and hereby states:

1. The land described above is within the oil-potash area as set forth in Order No. R-111-A, as amended in Case No. 278 before the O. C. C.
2. Potash Company of America is the owner and holder of a U. S. Government potash lease covering said land.
3. Drilling of a test well in the tract specified will result in waste of potash deposits of substantial value.
