ORDER OF THE COMMISSION

BY THE COMMISSION:

This cause came on for hearing at 9 o'clock a.m. on March 15, 1961, at Santa Fe, New Mexico, before the Oil Conservation Commission of New Mexico, hereinafter referred to as the "Commission."

NOW, on this 17th day of March, 1961, the Commission, a quorum being present, having considered the testimony presented and the exhibits received at said hearing, and being fully advised in the premises,

FINDS:

- (1) That due public notice having been given as required by law, the Commission has jurisdiction of this cause and the subject matter thereof.
- (2) That there is need for the creation of a new pool in Eddy County, New Mexico, for the production of oil from the Yates formation, said pool to bear the designation South Benson-Yates Pool. Said South Benson-Yates Pool was discovered by G. W. Strake, Union Federal Well No. 1, located in the SE/4 of Section 23, Township 19 South, Range 30 East, HMPM. It was completed December 20, 1960. The top of perforations is at 1742 feet.
- (3) That there is need for the creation of a new pool in Lea County, New Mexico, for the production of oil from the Delaware formation, said pool to hear the designation Double X-Delaware Pool. Said Double X-Delaware Pool was discovered by Tennessee Gas Transmission Company, U. S. Smelting Well No. 1, located in the NE/4 of Section 22, Township 24 South, Range 32 East, HMPM. It was completed January 18, 1961. The top of perforations is at 4919 feet.
