ORDER OF THE COMMISSION

BY THE COMMISSION:

This cause came on for hearing at 9 o'clock a.m. on June 14, 1961, at Santa Fe, New Mexico, before the Oil Conservation Commission of New Mexico, hereinafter referred to as the "Commission."

NOW, on this 16th day of June, 1961, the Commission, a quorum being present, having considered the testimony presented and the exhibits received at said hearing, and being fully advised in the premises,

FINDS:

(1) That due public notice having been given as required by law, the Commission has jurisdiction of this cause and the subject matter thereof.

(2) That there is need for certain extensions to the Cha Cha-Gallup Oil Pool, to the Horseshoe-Gallup Oil Pool, to the Shiprock-Gallup Oil Pool and to the Totah-Gallup Oil Pool in San Juan County, New Mexico, and to the Ballard-Pictured Cliffs Pool in Rio Arriba, Sandoval and San Juan Counties, New Mexico.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

(a) That the Ballard-Pictured Cliffs Pool in Rio Arriba, Sandoval and San Juan Counties, New Mexico, as heretofore classified, defined, and described, be and the same is hereby extended to include therein:

TOWNSHIP 26 NORTH, RANGE 7 WEST, NMPM  
Section 19: SW/4

(b) That the Cha Cha-Gallup Oil Pool in San Juan County, New Mexico, as heretofore classified, defined, and described,

be and the same is hereby extended to include therein:

TOWNSHIP 29 NORTH, RANGE 14 WEST, NMPM  
Section 22: NW/4 and W/2 NE/4  
Section 34: E/2 NE/4

(c) That the Horseshoe-Gallup Oil Pool in San Juan County, New Mexico, as heretofore classified, defined, and described, be and the same is hereby extended to include therein:

TOWNSHIP 30 NORTH, RANGE 16 WEST, NMPM  
Section 2: NE/4 NW/4 and NW/4 NE/4

TOWNSHIP 31 NORTH, RANGE 16 WEST, NMPM  
Section 26: S/2 SW/4 and SW/4 SE/4

(d) That the Shiprock-Gallup Oil Pool in San Juan County, New Mexico, as heretofore classified, defined, and described, be and the same is hereby extended to include therein:

TOWNSHIP 29 NORTH, RANGE 18 WEST, NMPM  
Section 16: NW/4 SW/4  
Section 17: N/2 SE/4 and NE/4 SW/4

(e) That the Totah-Gallup Oil Pool in San Juan County, New Mexico, as heretofore classified, defined, and described, be and the same is hereby extended to include therein:

TOWNSHIP 29 NORTH, RANGE 13 WEST, NMPM  
Section 19: NW/4  
Section 20: W/2 SE/4  
Section 30: E/2 NE/4  
Section 35: W/2 SW/4

TOWNSHIP 29 NORTH, RANGE 14 WEST, NMPM  
Section 24: E/2 NE/4

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED:

That the effective date of this order and all the extensions herein shall be July 1, 1961.
