In support of this Application, Applicant respectfully states and shows the following:

1. An orthodox location is anticipated and will be staked seven hundred and sixty-five feet (765') from the north line and three thousand one hundred and seventy-five feet (3175') from the east line of Section 30, T-29-N, R-13-W. When staked, the well will be known as the Hagood #28-G.

2. Applicant owns all the acreage within the non-standard unit. Operators owning offsetting acreage are Humble Oil Company, Pan American Petroleum Corporation and Elliott, Inc., and each has been furnished a copy of this Application with a request that their consent

3. The non-standard unit consists of contiguous quarter-quarter sections or lots.

4. The non-standard unit lies wholly within a single governmental section.

6. The length or width of the non-standard unit does not exceed five thousand two hundred and eighty feet (5280').

Applicant respectfully requests that this Application be promptly considered and that approval be administratively granted, pursuant to Rule 2 of Order R-1882, for the non-standard unit above described.
