1. It is the owner and operator of certain properties
situated within the boundaries of the Jalmat Gas Pool, being the
SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 4 and the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 9, Township 23 South, Range
36 East, N.M.P.M., Lea County, New Mexico.

2. It desires to create a non-standard gas proration
unit consisting of the two above-described 160 acre tracts and
dedicate to said unit the production from its State A Account No.
1, Well No. 18, situated 660 feet from the south and west lines of
Section 4, Township 23 South, Range 36 East. Applicant plans to
abandon its State A Account No. 1, Well No. 14, situated 660 feet
from the west line and 1980 feet from the north line of Section 9,
Township 23 South, Range 36 East.

3. The granting of the application will be in the interest
of conservation and correlative rights will not be adversely affected.

WHEREFORE, Applicant requests the Commission to set this
matter down for hearing before an Examiner, to publish notice as

required by law, and, after hearing, to issue its order approving the non-standard gas proration unit as requested.

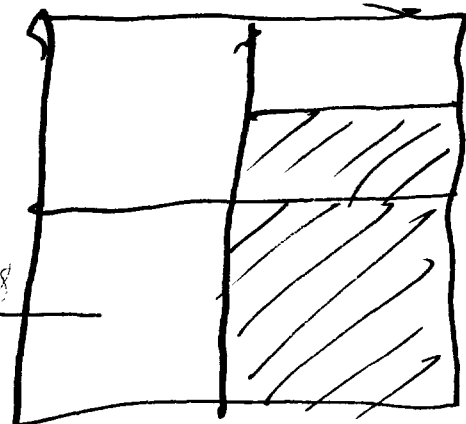
