ORDER OF THE COMMISSION

BY THE COMMISSION:

This cause came on for hearing at 9 o'clock a.m. on July 6, 1961, at Santa Fe, New Mexico, before Daniel S. Nutter, Examiner duly appointed by the Oil Conservation Commission of New Mexico, hereinafter referred to as the "Commission," in accordance with Rule 1214 of the Commission Rules and Regulations.

NOW, on this 13th day of July, 1961, the Commission, a quorum being present, having considered the application, the evidence adduced, and the recommendations of the Examiner, Daniel S. Nutter, and being fully advised in the premises,

FINDS:

- (1) That due public notice having been given as required by law, the Commission has jurisdiction of this cause and the subject matter thereof.
- (2) That the applicant, Wolfson Oil Company, seeks the establishment of a 160-acre non-standard gas unit adjacent to the North Skaggs-Drinkard Gas Pool, consisting of the S/2 SW/4 of Section 5 and the N/2 NW/4 of Section 8, all in Township 20 South, Range 38 East, NMPM, Lea County, New Mexico.
- (3) That the proposed non-standard gas unit is presumed to be productive of gas from the North Skaggs-Drinkard Gas Pool.
- (4) That approval of the subject application will neither cause waste nor impair correlative rights.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

- (1) That a 160-acre non-standard gas unit adjacent to the North Skaggs-Drinkard Gas Pool is hereby established, consisting of the S/2 SW/4 of Section 5 and the N/2 NW/4 of Section 8, all in Township 20 South, Range 38 East, NMPM, Lea County, New Mexico.
- (2) That jurisdiction of this cause is retained for the entry of such further orders as the Commission may deem necessary.
