

TEXACO Inc. respectfully requests that a hearing be set to consider its application for an unorthodox well location for the Cotton Draw Unit Well No. 54, located in the Paduca (Delaware) Field, Lea County, New Mexico. In support of its application TEXACO Inc. wishes to state the following facts:

1. The Cotton Draw Unit Well No. 54 has been completed at a location 2339' from the east line and 1980' from the north line of Section 28, T-25-S, R-32-E, Lea County, New Mexico.
2. The location of the well is unorthodox in that it is located nearer than 330' to the quarter-quarter section line.
