A P P L I C A T I O N

Come now William A. Hudson and Edward R. Hudson, doing business as Hudson & Hudson, and apply to the Oil Conservation Commission of New Mexico for an order approving two five-spot locations as ~~unorthodox~~ well locations in the Maljamar pool, as follows:

- (a) Puckett "A" Well No. 23, to be located within 100 feet but not closer than 25 feet to the Southeast corner of Unit J, Section 24, Township 17 South, Range 31 East, N.M.P.M.
- (b) Puckett "B" Well No. 21, to be located within 100 feet but not closer than 25 feet to the Northwest corner of Unit Q, Section 24, Township 17, South, Range 31 East, N.M.P.M.

It is proposed that said wells be completed as producing wells, with production from any forty-acre tract limited to one top unit allowable.

The Commission, by its Order No. R-1693, entered June 1, 1960, has heretofore approved similar five-spot locations in this same area and section, and the present application is in

furtherance of the development of the leases involved in accordance with the plan approved by said Order R-1693.

The location of said wells will not affect correlative rights of other operators nor cause waste. The proposed unorthodox locations will not crowd any offset operator.

There is attached hereto and make a part of this application a plat showing location of the proposed wells, together with lease-ownership in the areas involved in this application.
