

Gentlemen:

Reference is made to Case No. 2469, the application of El Paso Natural Gas Company for 160-acre proration units and a 4000 to 1 limiting gas-oil ratio for the Lusk Strawn Pool, Lea County, New Mexico, which was heard by me as trial examiner for the Commission January 4, 1962.

In order to properly evaluate the evidence presented at the hearing, we would appreciate receiving the following information, all related to the evidence submitted but in more detail:

1. Copy of the laboratory report of the analysis of the sub-surface fluid sample.
2. Copies of the core analyses of the cores taken in the Strawn formation in Unit Wells No. 1, No. 2, and No. 3, as prepared by the laboratory, as well as copies of the micro logs of the three wells.
3. An itemized cost accounting of the drilling, equipping, and dual completing of Unit Wells No. 1, No. 2, and No. 3.
