THE AFFLICATION OF THE OIL CONSERVATION COMMISSION UPON ITS OWN MOTION FOR AN ORDER CREATING, CONTRACTING, AND EXTENDING CERTAIN FOOLS IN EDDY AND LEA COUNTLES, NEW MERICO.

CRDER OF THE COMMISSION

BY THE COMMISSION:

This cause came on for hearing at 9 o'clock a.m. on January 17, 1962, at Janta Fe, New Mexico, before the Oil Conservation Commission of New Mexico, hereinafter referred to as the "Commission."

NCW, on this <u>19th</u> day of January, 1962, the Commission, a quorum being present, having considered the testimony presented and the exhibits received at said hearing, and being fully advised in the premises,

FINDS:

(1) That due public notice having been given as required by law, the Commission has jurisdiction of this cause and the subject matter thereof.

(2) That the proposed creation of a new pool in Section 25, Township 19 South, Range 30 East, Eddy County, New Mexico, for the production of oil from the Seven Rivers formation should be dismissed pending further study.

(3) That the proposed creation of a new pool in Section 24, Township 16 South, Range 30 East, Eddy County, New Mexico, for the production of oil from the Lower Wolfcamp formation should be dismissed pending further study.

(4) That there is need for the creation of a new pool in Lea County, New Mexico, for the production of oil from the Blinebry formation, said pool to bear the designation North Justis-Blinebry Fool. Said North Justis-Blinebry Pool was discovered by J. C. Williamson, Westates Federal Well -2-CASE NO. 2476 Order No. R-2172

No. 5, located in Unit E of Section 1, Township 25 South, Range 37 East, NMFM. It was completed September 1, 1961. The top of the perforations is 5270 feet. Special vertical limits are: Top pool at 5005 feet or -1867 feet subsea. Type log, electric log of the J. C. Williamson, Westates Federal Well No. 4, Unit E of Section 1, Township 25 South, Range 37 East, NMFM.

(5) That there is need for the creation of a new pool in Lea County, New Mexico, for the production of oil for the McKee formation, said pool to bear the designation North Justis-McKee Fool. Said North Justis-McKee Fool was discovered by Texaco, Inc. G. L. Erwin (b) NCT-2 No. 1 located in the SE/4, Unit F of Section 35, Township 24 South, Range 37 East NMFM. It was completed August 16, 1961. The top of perforations is 7928 feet.

(6) That there is need for the creation of a new pool in Lea County, New Mexico, for the production of oil from the Drinkard formation, said pool to bear the designation North Justis Tubb-Drinkard Lool. Said North Justis Tubb-Drinkard Fool was discovered by J. W. Williamson, Westates Federal No. 5, located in the NE/4, Unit E of Section 1, Township 25 South, Range 37 East, NMFM. It was completed August 4, 1961. The top of perforation is 5958 feet. Special Vertical limits are: Top pool at 5655 feet or -2517 feet subsea. Type log, electric log of the J. C. Williamson, Westates Federal Well No. 4, Unit E of Section 1, Township 25 South, Range 37 East, NMFM.

(7) That there is need for the creation of a new pool in Eddy County, New Mexico, for the production of oil from the Delaware Sand formation, said pool to bear the designation North Malaga-Delaware Fool. Said North Malaga-Delaware Fool was discovered by Ferry R. Bass, Julia Beemon et al No. 1 located in the SW/4, Unit K of Section 2, Township 24 South, Range 28 East, NMFM. It was completed August 19, 1954. The top of perforation is 4678 feet.

(δ) That there is need for the deletion of non-producing acreage from the Red Lake (Grayburg-San Andres) Fool.

(9) That there is need for certain extensions to the Arkansas Junction-Queen Gas Fool, the North Justis-Ellenburger Fool, the North Justis-Fusselman Fool, the Justis Tubb-Drinkard Fool, the Paddock Fool and the Vacuum-Abo Fool, all in Lea County, New Mexico, and to the South Benson-Yates Fool, the Cedar Lake-Abo Fool, the Fren-Seven Rivers Fool, the North Hackberry-Yates Fool, the Fecos-Delaware Fool, the East Red Lake-Queen Fool, the Shugart (Yates-Seven Rivers-Queen-Grayburg) Fool, the North Square Lake-Grayburg Fool, all in Eddy County, New Mexico. Further, that the proposed extension to the Empire-Faddock Fool in Eddy County, New Mexico, should be dismissed pending further study.

(10) That there is need for the extension of the vertical limits of the North Square Lake-Grayburg to include the San Andres formation. This pool shall be renamed the North Square Lake Grayburg-San Andres fool. -3-CASE NO. 2476 Order No. R-2172

IT IS THEREFORS ORDERED:

(a) That the proposed creation of a new pool in Eddy County, New Mexico, classified as an oil pool for Seven Rivers production, designated as the Hackberry-Seven Rivers Pool, consisting of the following described area:

> TOWNSHIP 19 SOUTH, RANGE 30 EAST, NMPM Section 25: NE/4

is hereby dismissed.

(b) That the proposed creation of a new pool in Eddy County. New Mexico, classified as an oil pool for Lower Wolfcamp production, designated as the Henshaw-Lower Wolfcamp Pool, consisting of the following described area:

> TOWNSHIP 16 SOUTH, RANGE 30 EAST, NMPM Section 24: W/2 a SE/4

is hereby dismissed.

(c) That a new pool in Lea County, New Mexico, classified as an oil pool for Blinebry production, is hereby created and designated as the North Justis-Blinebry Pool, consisting of the following described area:

> TOWNSHIP 25 SOUTH, RANGE 37 EAST, MMPM Section 1: NW/4

Special vertical limits, Top pool at 5005 feet or -1667 feet subsea. Type log, electric log of the J. C. Williamson, Westates Federal Well No. 4, Unit E of Section 1, Township 25 South, Range 37 East, NMFM.

(d) That a new pool in Lea County, New Mexico, classified as an oil pool for McKee production, is hereby created and designated as the North Justis-McKee Pool, consisting of the following described area:

> TOWNSHIF 24 SOUTH, RANGE 37 EAST, NMPM Section 35: SG/4 Section 36: SW/4

TOWNSHIF 25 SOUTH, RANGE 37 EAST, MMPM Section 1 : W/2 Section 2 : NE/4

(e) That a new pool in Lea County, New Mexico, classified as an oil pool for Drinkard production, is hereby created and designated as the North Justis Tubb-Drinkard Pool, consisting of the following described area: -4-CASE NO. 2476 Crder No. R-2172

TOUNSHIF 24 SOUTH, RANGE 37 EAST, NMFM Section 35: SE/4

TOWNSHIF 25 SOUTH, RANGE 37 EAST, NMFM Section 1: N/2 Section 2: NE/4

Special vertical limits, Top pool at 5655 feet or -2517 feet subsea. Type log, electric log of the J. C. Williamson, Westates Federal Well No. 4, Unit 5 of Section 1, Township 25 South, Range 37 East NMEM.

(f) That a new pool in Eddy County, New Mexico, classified as an oil pool for Delaware Sand production, is hereby created and designated as the North Malaga-Delaware Pool, consisting of the following described area:

(g) That the Red Lake-Grayburg-San Andres Fool in Eddy County, New Mexico, as heretofore classified, defined, and described, is hereby contracted by the deletion of the following described nonproductive area:


