Gentlemen:

Tenneco Oil Company hereby applies for permission to conduct a pressure maintenance by water injection in the Totah Gallup pool, San Juan County, New Mexico. Tenneco proposes to inject water into several wells on the Glenn H. Callow lease located in Sections 27, 28 and 33, T. 29 N., R. 13 W. In compliance with Rule No. 701 the following are attached: a plat showing the location of all wells in the area with injection wells so marked; an electric log of each injection well; a data sheet giving pertinent data on each of these proposed injection wells. It is proposed that water will be injected into the Gallup formation at an approximate depth of 5200-5700 feet. It is anticipated that the injection rate will be approximately 5000 BWPD. The source of this water is proposed to be the Pictured Cliff formation.


It is requested that this application be set for hearing during January, 1962, if possible.
