ORDER OF THE COMMISSION

BY THE COMMISSION:

This cause came on for hearing at 9 o'clock a.m. on February 27, 1962, at Santa Fe, New Mexico, before Elvis A. Utz, Examiner duly appointed by the Oil Conservation Commission of New Mexico, hereinafter referred to as the "Commission," in accordance with Rule 1214 of the Commission Rules and Regulations.

NOW, on this 14th day of March, 1962, the Commission, a quorum being present, having considered the application, the evidence adduced, and the recommendations of the Examiner, Elvis A. Utz, and being fully advised in the premises,

FINDS:

- (1) That due public notice having been given as required by law, the Commission has jurisdiction of this cause and the subject matter thereof.
- (2) That the applicant, G. W. Strake, seeks an order creating a new oil pool to be designated as either the Hackberry-Seven Rivers Fool or Hackberry-Capitan Pool, Section 25, Township 19 South, Range 30 East, NMFM, Eddy County, New Mexico.
- (3) That the evidence presented reflects that the proposed pool was discovered by the G. W. Strake Lebow-Federal Well No. 4, located 2310 feet from the North line and 990 feet from the East line of said Section 25, and that said well was completed in the Seven Rivers formation, a separate and distinct reservoir from the Hackberry-Yates Pool, with the top of the perforations at 2054 feet or 1311 feet above sea level.
- (4) That there is a need for the creation of a new oil pool consisting of the S/2 NE/4 and the NE/4 SE/4 of said Section 25 for the production of oil from the Seven Rivers formation, said pool to be designated the Hackberry-Seven Rivers Pool.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

(1) That a new pool in Eddy County, New Mexico, classified as an oil pool for Seven Rivers production, is hereby created and designated the Hackberry-Seven Rivers Pool, consisting of the following-described acreage:

TOWNSHIP 19 SOUTH, RANGE 30 EAST, NMPM Section 25: S/2 NE/4 and NE/4 SE/4

(2) That jurisdiction of this cause is retained for the entry of such further orders as the Commission may deem necessary.
