Comes now Cities Service Petroleum Company and applies to the Oil Conservation Commission of New Mexico for approval of the dual completion of its State AD Well No. 2, located 3300 feet from the North line and 660 feet from the East line of Section 22, Township 10 South, Range 32 East, N.M.P.M., Lea County, New Mexico, for the production of oil from the Pennsylvanian formation in the Nescalero Pool, and oil from the San Andres formation in an undesignated pool, and in support thereof would show the Commission:

- 1. Cities Service Petroleum Company's State AD Well No. 2
 was originally drilled as a Devonian well, and completed with
 5 1/2-inch casing.
- 2. It is proposed to re-complete said well, utilizing two strings of tubing, one of 2-inch tubing, and the other of 1 1/2-inch or 1 1/4-inch tubing, with a cross-over assembly, utilizing the 2-inch tubing for the long string.
- 3. Approval of this application is in the interests of conservation and the prevention of waste of the natural resources of the state.

WHEREFORE, applicant prays that this matter be set for hearing as soon as practicable, and after notice and hearing
