That Case No. 2583 is hereby dismissed.

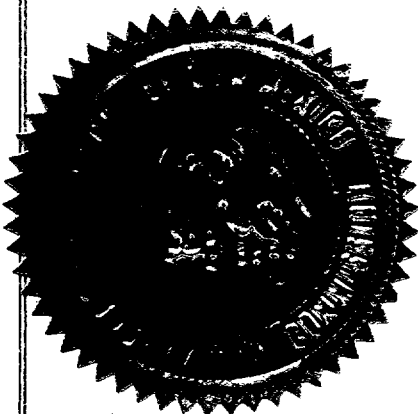
