Dear Mr. Yates:

Under date of November 13, 1961, you filed a Notice of Intention to Drill well Federal No. 1 in the NE\set sec. 9, T. 19 S., R. 30 E., N.M.P.M., Eddy County, New Mexico, on land included in lease New Mexico 02337, to a depth of 2,350 feet to test the Yates formation.

The proposed location is in the potash area prescribed by the Secretary of the Interior in his order of October 18, 1951, and is also in the area covered by New Mexico Oil Conservation Commission Order No. R-111-A.

In our opinion the drilling of the well would result in undue waste of potash deposits and constitute a hazard to, or unduly interfere with, mining operations being conducted for the extraction of potash deposits.

Pursuant to authority delegated to the Regional Oil and Gas Supervisor on May 10, 1962, 27 F. R. 4814, I hereby deny approval of the Notice of Intention to Drill described in the foregoing.
