TRANSCRIPT OF HEARING

MR. PORTER: Take up next Case 2667, Southeastern

New Mexico nomenclature case.

DAN NUTTER, called as a witness, having been previously duly sworn, testified as follows:

DIRECT EXAMINATION

BY MR. DURRETT:

- Q Will you please state your name and position?
- A Dan Nutter, Chief Engineer for the Oil Conservation Commission.
- Q Are you prepared today to recommend to the Commission that an order be entered creating new pools and extending certain existing pools in Lea County, New Mexico?
 - A Yes.
- Q Have you prepared this recommendation in the form of an exhibit?



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- Yes, sir.
- Referring to paragraph A of that exhibit, what is your 0 recommendation concerning the creation of a new oil pool for Queen production?

I would recommend that the Mesaverde-Queen Pool be created, comprising the Northwest Quarter. Township 16 South, Range 32 East, Section 16. The discovery well for the pool was the Carters Drilling Company, Mobil State No. 1 in Unit E of such Section 16. It was completed August 20, 1962, and the top of the perforation is 3,400 feet.

- Mr. Nutter, do the rest of your recommendations concern extensions of certain existing pools?
 - Yes, sir, they do. A
- Would you please refer to specific paragraphs of your exhibit and give us your recommendations?

I would recommend that the pools be extended in accordance with the extensions depicted on the docket and on the exhibit, with two exceptions in paragraph G of the docket. is an extension given which I would recommend be adopted and also that the East Half of Section 18, Township 19 South, Range 2 South also be added in paragraph I. I would recommend two pools be amended with the pool, with this docket and also the Southeast Quarter of Section 7 be included in the pool. Otherwise the extensions are all as they appear on the docket and on the exhibit.
