ORDER OF THE COMMISSION

BY THE COMMISSION:

This cause came on for hearing at 9 o'clock a.m., on April 17, 1963, at Santa Fe, New Mexico, before the Oli Conservation Commission of New Mexico, hereinafter referred to as the "Commission."

NOW, on this 22nd day of April, 1963, the Commission, a quorum being present, having considered the testimony presented and the exhibits received at said hearing, and being fully advised in the premises,

FINDS:

- (1) That due public notice having been given as required by law, the Commission has jurisdiction of this cause and the subject matter thereof.
- (2) That there is need for the creation of a new pool in Lea County, New Mexico, for the production of oil from the Wolfcamp formation, said pool to bear the designation of Inbe-Wolfcamp Pool. Said Inbe-Wolfcamp Pool was discovered by Sun Oil Company, State of New Mexico "A" No. 1, located in Unit O of Section 7, Township 11 South, Range 34 East, NMPM. It was completed in Wolfcamp on January 1, 1963. The top of the perforations is at 9310 feet.

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- (3) That there is need for the creation of a new pool in Lea County, New Mexico, for the production of oil from the Bone Springs formation, said pool to bear the designation of Teas-Bone Springs Pool. Said Teas-Bone Springs Pool was discovered by Sinclair Oil & Gas Company, Mahaffey Federal ARC No. 1, located in Unit C of Section 14, Township 20 South, Range 33 East, NMPM. It was completed in Bone Springs on December 6, 1962. The top of the perforations is at 9408 feet.
- (4) That there is need for the consolidation of the Vacuum-Queen and EK-Queen Pools, Lea County, New Mexico, inasmuch as the pools are contiguous and produce from the same formation, said consolidation to be accomplished by the abolishment of the Vacuum-Queen Pool and the extension of the EK-Queen Pool.
- (5) That there is need for the consolidation of the Henshaw-Queen Gas and Henshaw-San Andres Pools, Eddy County, New Mexico, inasmuch as production from the Queen formation is classified as non-commercial, said consolidation to be accomplished by the abolishment of the Henshaw-Queen Gas Pool, the extension of vertical limits of the consolidated pool to include the Grayburg formation and changing the pool name to Henshaw Queen-Grayburg-San Andres Pool.
- (6) That there is need for the correction of nomenclature by the deletion of certain acreage in the Robinson (Grayburg-San Andres) Pool, Lea County, New Mexico. The Maljamar Pool to be extended to include a portion of the deleted area.
- (7) That there is need for certain extensions to the Corbin-Abo Pool, the North Justis-Fusselman Pool, the Mesa-Queen Pool, the Oil Center-Blinebry Pool, the South Tonto-Yates Pool and the Vacuum-Blinebry Pool, all in Lea County, New Mexico. Further, that the proposed extensions to the West Henshaw-Grayburg Pool in Chaves County, New Mexico and the West Allison-Pennsylvanian Pool, the Milnesand-San Andres Pool, and the South Prairie-Pennsylvanian Pool, all in Roosevelt County, New Mexico, should be dismissed because of an error in legal advertising.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

(a) That a new pool in Lea County, New Mexico, classified as an oil pool for Wolfcamp production, is hereby created and designated as the Inbe-Wolfcamp Pool, consisting of the following-described area:

(b) That a new pool in Lea County, New Mexico, classified as an oil pool for Bone Springs production, is hereby created and designated as the Teas-Bone Springs Pool, consisting of the following-described area:

(c) That the Vacuum-Queen Pool in Lea County, New Mexico, consisting of the following-described area:

TOWNSHIP 18 SOUTH, RANGE 33 EAST, NMPM Section 1: E/2

TOWNSHIP 18 SOUTH, RANGE 34 EAST, NMPM Section 6: W/2 and SE/4

is hereby abolished.

(d) That the EK-Queen Pool in Lea County, New Mexico, as heretofore classified, defined, and described, is hereby extended to include therein:

(e) That the Robinson (Grayburg-San Andres) Pool in Lea County, New Mexico, as heretofore classified, defined, and described, is hereby contracted by the deletion of the following-described area:

(f) That the Maljamar Pool in Lea County, New Mexico, as heretofore classified, defined, and described, is hereby extended

(g) That the proposed extension to the West Allison-Pennsylvanian Pool in Roosevelt County, New Mexico, as heretofore classified, defined, and described, to include therein:

is hereby dismissed.

(h) That the Corbin-Abo Pool in Lea County, New Mexico, as heretofore classified, defined, and described, is hereby extended to include therein:

(i) That the proposed extension to the West Henshaw-Grayburg Pool in Chaves County, New Mexico, as heretofore classified, defined, and described, to include therein:

(c) That the South Tonto-Yates Pool in Lea County, New Mexico, as heretofore classified, defined, and described, is hereby extended to include therein:

(p) That the Vacuum-Blinebry Pool in Lea County, New Mexido, as heretafore classified, defined, and described, is hereby extended to include therein:

Section 25: NW/6 Section 26: SE/4

(q) That the Henshaw-Queen Gas Pool in Eddy County, New Mexico, comprising the SE/4 of Section 13, Township 16 South,

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Range 30 East, is hereby <u>abolished</u> and the vertical limits of the Henshaw-San Andres Pool comprising all of said Section 13 are hereby <u>extended</u> to include the Queen and Grayburg formations, and the name of said pool <u>changed</u> to Henshaw Queen-Grayburg-San Andres Pool.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED:

That the effective date of this order and all creations, abolishments, deletions, change of vertical limits, change of pool names, and extensions included herein shall be May 1, 1963.
