ORDER OF THE COMMISSION

BY THE COMMISSION:

This cause came on for hearing at 9 o'clock a.m. on April 24, 1963, at Santa Fe, New Mexico, before Elvis A. Utz, Examiner duly appointed by the Oil Conservation Commission of New Mexico, hereinafter referred to as the "Commission," in accordance with Rule 1214 of the Commission Rules and Regulations.

NOW, on this 8th day of May, 1963, the Commission, a quorum being present, having considered the application, the evidence adduced, and the recommendations of the Examiner, Elvis A. Utz, and being fully advised in the premises,

FINDS:

(1) That due public notice having been given as required by law, the Commission has jurisdiction of this cause and the subject matter thereof.

(2) That the applicant, Socony Mobil Oil Company, Inc., seeks authority to complete its State Bridges Well No. 96, located in Unit H of Section 26, Township 17 South, Range 34 East, NMPM, Lea County, New Mexico, as a triple completion (conventional) to produce oil from the North Vacuum-Abo, the Vacuum-Wolfcamp, and the Vacuum-Pennsylvanian Pools through parallel strings of 2 3/8-inch tubing, with separation of zones by packers set at approximately 9400 feet and 11,350 feet.

(3) That the mechanics of the proposed triple completion are feasible and in accord with good conservation practices.

(4) That approval of the subject application will neither cause waste nor impair correlative rights.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

(1) That the applicant, Socony Mobil Oil Company, Inc., is hereby authorized to complete its State Bridges Well No. 96, located in Unit H of Section 26, Township 17 South, Range 34 East, NMPM, Lea County, New Mexico, as a triple completion (conventional) to produce oil from the North Vacuum-Abo, the Vacuum-Wolfcamp, and the Vacuum-Pennsylvanian Pools through parallel strings of 2 3/8-inch tubing, with separation of zones by packers set at approximately 9400 feet and 11,350 feet.

PROVIDED HOWEVER, That the applicant shall complete, operate, and produce said well in accordance with the provisions of Rule 112-A of the Commission Rules and Regulations insofar as said rule is not inconsistent with this order.

PROVIDED FURTHER, That the applicant shall take packer-leakage tests upon completion and annually thereafter during the Gas-Oil Ratio Test Period for the Vacuum-Pennsylvanian Pool.

(2) That jurisdiction of this cause is retained for the entry of such further orders as the Commission may deem necessary.
