TRANSCRIPT OF HEARING

MR. UTZ: The hearing will come to order, please. Case 2816.

MR. DURRETT: In the matter of the hearing called by the Oil Conservation Commission on its own motion to permit C. T. Robertson and all other interested parties to appear and show cause why the Honolulu State "B" Wells Nos. 4 and 5 in Units G and H, respectively, of Section 11, Township 11 South, Range 27 East, Chaves County, New Mexico, should not be plugged in accordance with a Commission-approved plugging program.

If the Examiner please, I would like to state for the record at this time that both of these locations are on State land and that the alleged offense in this case is failure to fill pits

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that are located on these locations, and I have had a conference with Mr. Oscar Jordan, the attorney for the State Land Office, since this case was docketed and as a result of that conference we have determined that the State Land Office has primary jurisdiction in this matter; and I would like to move to dismiss this case at this time, and it will be turned over to the State Land Office if the motion is granted, for whatever procedure they would feel would be appropriate under the circumstances, since this is a State lease.

MR. UTZ: Failure to fill pits is still a failure to follow Commission rules.

MR. DURRETT: There's a question about that. That's the reason I want to turn it to the State Land Office. The only requirement we have in the rules is that pits must be filled before a C-103 plugging form can be approved and there can't be any plugging form approved until the wells have been drilled. There are no wells drilled. They are just locations staked and pits dug. We feel it would be appropriate to turn it to the State Land Office and on that basis I would move to dismiss the case.

MR. UTZ: Case 2816 will be dismissed.
