It appearing to the Commission that due to clerical error,  
Order No. R-2966, dated September 13, 1965, does not correctly  
state the intended order of the Commission,

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

(1) That the portion of Paragraph (1) of Order No. R-2966  
reading:

"Tidewater-Coates "C" Well No. 28, to be located 1820 feet  
from the North line and 1820 feet from the South line  
of Section 24."

is hereby stricken, and

"Tidewater-Coates "C" Well No. 28, to be located 1820 feet  
from the North line and 1820 feet from the West line  
of Section 24."

is hereby interlineated in lieu thereof.

(2) That the correction set forth above shall be effective  
nunc pro tunc as of September 13, 1965.
