AFFIDAVIT OF POSSIBLE NEW OIL DISCOVERY

Texas Pacific Oil Company spudded subject well on 6-3-67 and drilled to a total depth of 7895'. Texas Pacific Oil Company believing this may be a new oil discovery well submits the following data:

On 7-9-67 Reached depth of 7521' and ran DST #1 7440 - 7521' with a slight show of oil and strong blow.

On 7-16-67 Reached TD and ran DST #2 7734 - 7895'. Strong blow with GTS-13 min.; Mud to surface-18 min. and heavy show of oil.

On 7-26-67 Perforated Pre-Ellenburger formation 7843-45-48-62' and acidized w/2750 gal. acid. Potential test reported to O.C.C. on Form C-104 on 7-28-67. Tested 408 BOPD + 10 BWPD 328 MCFPD. Allowable assigned was 112 BOPD.

On 8-3-67 Perforated Ellenburger-Joins formation 7783-91-94-98-7801'. Acidized w/250 gal. acid. Potential test reported to O.C.C. on Form C-104 on 8-15-67. Tested 370 BOPD No water 439 MCFPD.

On 9-6-67 Hearing was held in Santa Fe and permission was granted for dual completion of this well. At this time we were advised to file C-109 "Application for Discovery Allowable" which is pending until after the meeting scheduled 9-14-67 with Joe Ramey of the Hobbs Oil Conservation Commission.

I hereby certify the information given above is true and complete to the best of my knowledge and I, Sheldon Ward-Area Superintendent, am duly authorized to make this affidavit in behalf of Texas Pacific Oil Company.
