Gentlemen:

As you no doubt know, we have been granted a rehearing before the Oil Conservation Commission of the State of New Mexico in its Case No. 2504 which will be heard September 13, 1962. The Order of the Commission granting the rehearing states that the scope of the rehearing should be limited to matters pertaining to recoverable gas reserves in the Basin Dakota pool.

We enclose with this a list of some of your wells. We also enclose a blank data sheet listing reservoir information needed for the determination of recoverable gas reserves. We respectfully request that as to the wells designated on the first list you provide to us, at your earliest convenience and prior to September 10, 1962, all of the information suggested by the data sheet. This should include, if you have made the calculations, your determinations of recoverable gas reserves. If you do not have any particular item of information, we would appreciate your furnishing all that you do have.

Will you please advise us if you plan to attend the rehearing and, if so, whether you can have a witness available to testify to the recoverable reserve information for each of your wells.
