Comes now Shell Oil Company by its Attorneys Seth, Montgomery, Federici & Andrews and applies to the Oil Conservation Commission of New Mexico for approval of the dual completion of the Emerald Unit Well #1 and in support of this application states:

1. That the Emerald Unit Well #1 is located 660 feet from the North line and 1980 feet from the West line of Section 23, Township 16 South, Range 32 East, Lea County, New Mexico.

2. That Shell Oil Company proposes to complete this well as a dual completion (conventional) in the Penrose and Wolfcamp formations with the production of oil from both zones to be through strings of two and three-eighths (2-3/8) inch tubing.

3. That the mechanics of the proposed dual completion are set forth more fully on the diagram attached to this application.

4. That at this time no pool has been created for either the Penrose or the Wolfcamp formation in this area.

WHEREFORE, applicant requests that this application be set for hearing before one of the Commission's examiners and that the Commission enter its Order approving this dual completion.
