PETITION

COMES NOW Texas Pacific Coal and Oil Company through its attorneys, Campbell & Russell, and states:

- 1. That the Oil Conservation Commission entered Order Number R-69-D in Case Number 249 (Consolidated with Case Number 315) on June 30, 1954.
- 2. Order Number R-69-D provided for 80 acre spacing of wells and the establishing of 80 acre proration units in the Bagley-Siluro Devonian Pool, Lea County, New Mexico.
- 3. Since the entry of Order Number R-69-D there has been a change in the reservoir conditions in the Bagley-Siluro-Devonian Pool and continuation of 80 acre spacing and 80 acre proration units is conducive to waste.

WHEREFORE, Applicant respectfully requests that the Commission set this Petition for hearing; that due and proper notice be given as required by law; that upon the conclusion of said hearing, the Commission enter its order rescinding Order Number R-69-D and enter its order establishing 40 acre spacing of wells and

40 acre proration units in the Bagley-Siluro-Devonian Pool, Lea County, New Mexico, and further providing for an allowable equal to the top allowable for the wells in the Bagley-Siluro-Devonian depth range calculated by the use of the 40 acre proportional factor as provided for in Rule 505 of the Rules and Regulations of the Oil Conservation Commission.
