PORTER: For the record, I have discussed with both parties the possibility of alternate dispositions of this case, the other dates that we might hear it on between now and January 1st, and it seems we could not arrive at a date that would be satisfactory to all concerned. So in view of the motion here and Mr. Kellahin's concurrence, or at least the fact that he does not resist the motion, the case will be continued to the regular hearing in January.
