Dear Sir,

Pan American Petroleum Corporation respectfully requests that a hearing be docketed to consider its application for adoption of temporary rules for the Fowler-Blinbry Oil Pool, Lea County, New Mexico.

In our opinion, the information available to date regarding this field indicates the necessity for, and we plan to request, the following temporary rules: (1) 80-acre well spacing; (2) all wells drilled or recompleted in the fields, subsequent to the effective date of the rules, to be located no closer than 660' to any outer boundary line of the 80-acre proration unit; and (3) optional proration units to consist of either the N/2, S/2, E/2, or W/2 of a governmental quarter section.

At the present time the subject field contains two producing oil wells, and in our opinion the establishment of the above rules on a temporary basis will be in the interest of conservation and protection of correlative rights.
