2. That applicant is informed and believes and upon such information and belief states that the proposed unit

area embraces all or substantially all of the geological or geophysical feature involved so that in the event of the discovery of oil or gas thereon, that said Unit Agreement will permit the producing area to be developed and operated in the interest of conservation and the prevention of waste of unitized substances.

- 3. That it is contemplated that applicant will be the operator of the unit area and it is proposed to drill an initial test well pursuant to the terms of the Unit Agreement to be located in the NE% of Section 11, Township 22 South, Range 35 East, N.M.P.M. and that said well will be drilled to a depth sufficient to test the Strawn reef but not to exceed a depth of 12,500 feet.
- 4. That applicant believes that in the event oil or gas in paying quantities is discovered on the lands within the unit area, that the pool or field can be developed more economically and efficiently under the terms of said Unit Agreement, to the end that the maximum recovery of unitized substances will be obtained and that said Unit Agreement is in the interest of conservation and the prevention of waste as contemplated by the New Mexico Oil Conservation Commission statutes and regulations.
- 5. That upon an order being entered by the New Mexico Oil Conservation Commission approving said Unit Agreement, and after approval thereof by the Commissioner of Public Lands of the State of New Mexico, an approved copy will be filed with

the New Mexico Oil Conservation Commission.

WHEREFORE, the undersigned applicant respectfully requests that a hearing be held before an examiner on the matter of the approval of said Unit Agreement and that upon said hearing, said Unit Agreement be approved by the New Mexico Oil Conservation Commission as being in the interest of conservation and the prevention of waste.
