APPLICATION

Comes now SHELL OIL COMPANY, by its attorneys, and applies to the New Mexico Oil Conservation Commission for approval of the Comanche (San Andres) A, B, C, D, E and F unit agreements, Chaves County, New Mexico, and in support of its application states:

1. Attached to and made a part of this application are copies of Comanche (San Andres) A, B, C, D, E and F unit agreements, each of which embraces federal, state and fee lands in Chaves County, New Mexico, as depicted on Exhibit "A" to each unit agreement. A schedule of the ownership in each tract in each unit agreement and a schedule of that tract's participation is as shown on Exhibit "B" and Exhibit "C" to each unit agreement.

2. Each of the subject unit agreements is being formed for the purpose of the development of the unitized formations which are defined in Section 2, subparagraph 'h' of each unit agreement as including all formations from the surface to and including the San Andres formation. Development of the unitized formations will be accomplished pursuant to Sections 11 and 12 of each unit agreement.

3. Approval by the New Mexico Oil Conservation Commission of the proposed unit agreements will facilitate the development of the subject acreage in accordance with good conservation practices, preventing waste and protecting correlative rights.

WHEREFORE, Shell Oil Company requests that this application be set for hearing before the Commission or one of its
