GEOLOGICAL REPORT - NORTH ANTELOPE RIDGE UNIT

LEA COUNTY, NEW MEXICO

LOCATION

The proposed North Antelope Ridge Unit is in the northeast Delaware Basin in southern Lea County, New Mexico, immediately northeast of Antelope Ridge (Morrow and Siluro-Devonian) field and 20 miles southwest of Eunice, New Mexico.

STRUCTURE

Seismic data of good to poor quality indicate a northeastsouthwest trending anticline having about 400 feet of closure at about Mississippian level. This culmination is on a northeast trending structural axis extending from Antelope Ridge field. The San Simon Swale (a near-surface depression filled with gravels) traverses northwestsoutheast across the center of the unit. Seismic data in this swale are of poor quality; consequently, we have located the initial test on the crest of the structure in Section 22 where data are good. A well defined syncline separates the proposed unit from the Antelope Ridge Unit to the south, and pronounced synclines bound the west, north and east sides. The unit outline is determined by the lewest closing contour which covers all or significant parts of Sections 11, 12, 13, 14, 15, 22 and 23, Township 23-South, Range 3h-East, NMPM.

OBJECTIVES

Principal objectives are Pennsylvanian-Morrow sandstones and Siluro Devonian dolomite which are productive at Antelope Ridge and Bell Lake fields

UNITIZED SUBSTANCES

to the southwest.

All formations below the surface.

SUMMARY

We plan to drill a 14,800-foot Siluro-Devonian test in the Southwest 1/4 Northeast 1/4 of Section 22, Township 23-South, Range 34-East, NMPM,






