We have reviewed the application furnished by your letter of December 20, 1967 calling for the establishment of special rules and regulations for the Akah-Nez-Devonian oil pool, San Juan County, New Mexico. Based upon information furnished by the completion of your well No. 1 Navajo J in the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$  sec. 23, T. 23 N., R. 20 W., the proposed rules and regulations provide for 80 acre well spacing and an 80 acre proration factor for allowable purposes.
