



(b) Create a new pool in Eddy County, New Mexico, classified as a gas pool for Morrow production and designated as the Boyd-Morrow Gas Pool. The discovery well is Yates Petroleum Corporation's Boyd BN Gas Com No. 1 located in Unit H of Section 15, Township 19 South, Range 25 East, NMPM. Said pool should comprise:

TOWNSHIP 19 SOUTH, RANGE 25 EAST, NMPM
SECTION 15: E/2
